MEMBERSHIP

I. STATUS

The South India Textile Research Association, sponsored by the Textile Industry and supported by the Government of India, was formed and registered as an autonomous Scientific Research organisation in the year 1951 under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. SITRA is a link in the chain of premier national laboratories in the Country. The affairs of the Association are managed by a Council of Administration consisting of representatives from the Industry, Central and State Governments, other Textile Research Associations, CSIR, Southern India Mills' Association, Scientists etc.

II. OBJECTIVES

The main objectives are:

- . To undertake fundamental, applied and operational research on problems of particular interest to the Textile Industry.
- . To implement results of Research in all Member Units in order to improve Quality, increase productivity, reduce cost and develop new products and processes.
- . To offer consultancy services on various aspects of running a textile mill.

III. MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

The following categories of Membership are available:

1. FULL MEMBERSHIP
2. ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP

IV. MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

The Membership facilities as well as services available to FULL MEMBERS and ASSOCIATE MEMBERS are identical except that Associate Members do not have any voting rights.

Salient features of Membership facilities

- (a) Entitlement of research findings - all Research / Study Reports, Publications, News Letters, etc are made available to Members, free of cost.
- (b) Liaison visits to mills - in case of Member mills within the country, visits will be made free of cost. In case of Members abroad, all travelling and halting expenses for such visits will have to be borne by the concerned mill.
- (c) Inter-firm Studies on Financial Performance and Productivity will be made available free of cost.
- (d) Other services - Testing, Training and Consultancy are being made available on priority, at concessional rates.
- (e) Library - SITRA has a well-stocked Library containing more than 22,000 volumes of books and subscribing to nearly 200 journals. Two Library Cards are made available to Members for borrowing books.
